Dear Parents,

As we approach the Easter break many of us will have the chance to relax and recharge. However, for our Year 11,12 &13 pupils, this holiday time will be spent in study rather than on a sandy beach. However, many practical assessments in Art, Languages and in the sciences have already been completed.

As with all external examinations we follow strict procedures on the storage, access and opening of examinations. The papers are sent to us by courier and arrive in sealed packages. These are then stored in a safe and they are opened in the examination hall in the presence of the pupils. The completed examination

scripts are collected and then dispatched by courier to the external corrector. We believe that we have very thorough processes in place and I have the responsibility for the careful oversight of these procedures.

However, we all live and work where some level of stress is encountered and we work with pupils to assist them to deal with stress and to use acceptable levels of stress to boost performance. Using the analogy of sport, the real test of ability is in the game situation where the skills of the practice pitch are transferred to a competitive game. Our examination pupils are, we believe, match fit for the upcoming assessments. Pupils have had past papers and some have had mock examinations.

I wish our senior pupils all the very best in their forthcoming examinations that begin in May and may you experience just the right level of stress to perform at your best on the day.

This week we also saw a range of talented performances as BISC Factor drew a large audience and I thoroughly enjoyed the 8 acts on display. We had talents from across the globe and I congratulate all the performers. My special congratulations to our top three acts: in third place, Gayeon, Li Hyun, Yuna, and Yeyn gave a dazzling performance of K-Pop; in second place, Julia and Magda thrilled us with their football skills and Alex Peck came out on top with his amazing guitar skills and stage presence. Certainly this was one of the highlights of this academic year and I thank Ms Iwona, Ms Jen, Mr Maciej, Mr Danny

and Ms Aysha for all their work to make it happen. I also thank Ms Veronica, our Spanish teacher, for her wonderful singing, Mrs Lee for the scenery and to Daria and Borys for their guest appearances.



## Secondary School visiting German Consulate

On Monday March 27 the students from the Secondary School visited the German Consulate in Wroclaw. The beautiful building is on the banks of the Podwale, next to Galeria Dominikańska. The purpose of our trip was to learn about diplomatic service as a career and also about the role of consulates/embassies in general.

Lower Silesia and Germany have obvious historical links and there is still a sizable population of Germans living here today who require the service of the consulate from time to time. The consulate provides assistance with administrative issues (passports etc.) but a large part of their role is to promote trade between Silesia and Germany. In times of crisis (for example if a natural disaster occurred), the consulate will also provide emergency assistance to Germans in the region.

Almut Henkleman-Siaw, our host for the morning, has had a forty year career in the diplomatic service. She has lived all over the world in countries such as Indonesia and Senegal and in summer she is being sent to Miami!

To be a successful diplomat you have to be open, prepared to learn different languages and travel frequently, you also need to be a very good listener. Almut also explained that it can often be difficult to get used to being in a country so different from your own so an open mind and a willingness to put up with hardship really helps.

We are all very grateful for the effort that the busy staff put in to our visit and hope to continue relations with them in the future.


