2. News on gardening project



BISC students, years 3-11, are invited to take part in 2016 International Torrance Legacy Creativity Contest in Creative Writing, and/or Visual Arts, Inventions, and Music Composition. Applications for students are available on the board in the Big Villa and in the Small Villa hallways. This year you may e-mail the entries in Creative Writing, Visual Arts, and Inventions directly. Music entries need to be sent by post or may be submitted, with application and parent consent, to Mrs. Schier before June 24. Visual Arts require PHOTOS (not originals), as do Inventions.

Over the last four years, many BISC students have won numerous awards in this international competition whose sponsors for the 2016 include: The American National Association for Gifted Children, the Torrance Center for Creativity and Talent Development, Future Problem Solving Program International, and Center for Gifted/Midwest Torrance Center for Creativity.

Dr. E. Paul Torrance, known around the world as "the Father of Creativity," dedicated his life toward ways to assess creativity of children and adults. His nearly 60 years of research became a huge springboard from which much of the research in the field of gifted education originated. Dr. Torrance was the author of the Torrance Tests of Creative Thinking (TTCT), and his creative legacy continues to influence the lives of students worldwide through his Future Problem Solving Program, with 300 000 participants each year. Torrance's "Manifesto for Children" affirms creativity as the highest form of thinking, and says:

Don't be afraid to fall in love with something and pursue it with intensity.

Know, understand, take pride in, practice, develop,

Exploit and enjoy your greatest strengths.

Learn to free yourself from the expectations of others and

Walk away from the games they impose on you.

Free yourself to play your own game.

Find a teacher or mentor who will help you.


Learn the skills of interdependence.


