

MALTA FESTIVAL 2016

Between 12th and 18th June, five pupils from BISC Krakow and five pupils from BISC Wroclaw took part in the Young Malta Drama Festival in Poznan. This is the third occasion when BISC schools have taken part in this prestigious event and I have to say that it was the best festival ever! The festival theme was Actor / Witness / Spectator and each of these was incorporated into all activities.

Each day our pupils took part in warm-up sessions, various workshops which included drama, art and drumming, and in the afternoons we all became actors, witnesses and spectators by viewing each other's performances. This was followed by a collective discussion session and rehearsals in the evening. On Thursday and Friday we created and rehearsed a piece which incorporated all aspects of the workshops and our individual plays.
